Key Knowledge – What I will know at the end of the unit

- Christians believe in God, and that they find out about God in the Bible.
- Christians believe that God is loving, kind, fair and forgiving, and also Lord and King.
- Some stories show these Christian beliefs.
- A parable is a special sort of story that Jesus used to tell to help people learn or understand ideas.
- Christians worship God and try to live in ways that please him.
- Christian prayers have 4 main types - praise, saying sorry, saying thank you and asking for something. Some prayers show all four types and some show just one or two.

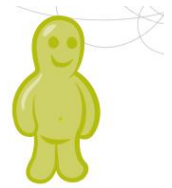
