I know what the key features of a mosque is

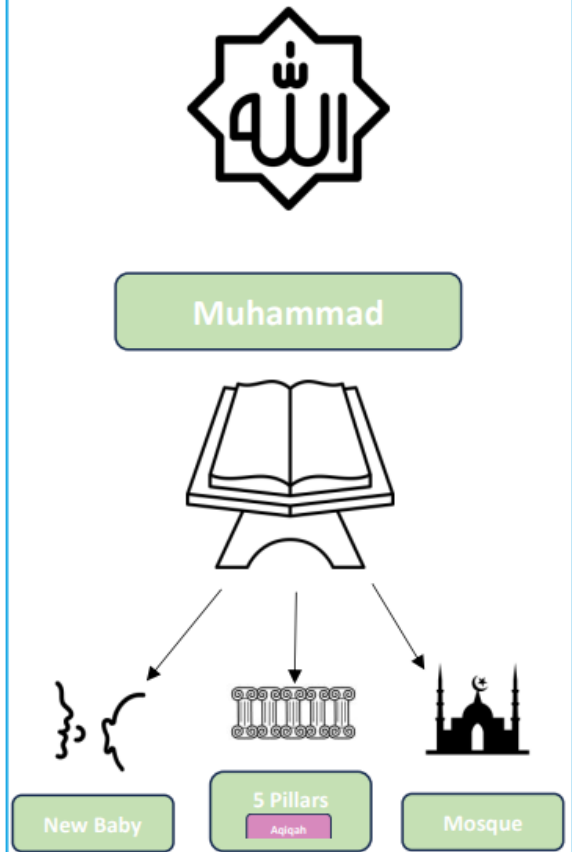
### Knowledge - What I will learn during this the unit

## Definition

**Shahadah** – A special sentence that says Muslims believe in one God and follow Muhammad.

**Zakat** – Giving to people who need help.

**Muslims** – People who believe in Islam.

**Hajj** – A special trip to a holy place called Mecca.

**Islam** – A religion that teaches people to believe in one God and be kind.

**Sawm** – Not eating or drinking in the daytime during Ramadan.

**Salah** – Praying to God five times every day.

**Tawhid** – The belief that there is only one God.

**Ramadan** – A special month when Muslims fast, pray, and be kind.

**Prophet** – A person chosen by God to teach people.
