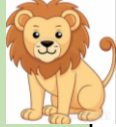

## Key Vocabulary

location	The place where something is.
address	The number, street and town where someone lives or a building is.
marshes	Wet, squishy land with lots of water and plants.
symbol	A picture or sign that stands for something
village	A small group of houses and buildings, smaller than a town.
holiday park	A place with caravans, cabins or tents where people stay for holidays.
nature reserve	A special place kept safe for animals, plants and nature.
range	A variety or a group of things
human feature	Something people have built, like houses, roads or shops.
physical feature	Something natural, like rivers, hills or beaches.
landmark	A well-known building or place that helps you know where you are.
diversity	Lots of different kinds of people, plants or animals.
fieldwork	Learning by going outside to study the world around you.
sense of place	The special feeling you get about a place that makes it different from other places.
guide	A person or book that helps you find out about a place.
trail	A path you can follow, often for a walk.
statue	A model of a person or animal, usually made of stone or metal.



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
