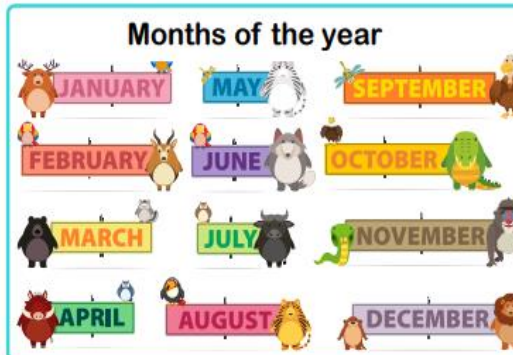
Sticky Learning
