Key Vocabulary	Definition
keyboard	An electrical instrument played like the piano.
bass	A stringed instrument that is low in pitch.
guitar	A six stringed instrument that is played by strumming of plucking.
percussion	Musical instruments that are used to establish rhythm.
trumpets	Brass wind instruments.
saxophones	Woodwind instruments that are made of brass.
pulse	The heartbeat or steady beat of a song/ piece of music.
rhythm	Patterns of long and short sounds used in music.
pitch	How high or low a note sounds.
improvise	To make up a tune and play it on the spot.
compose	Create and develop musical ideas.
perform	Sing and play instruments for others to hear.
audience	A group of people gathered to hear or see something.
