


Thank you to everyone who completed the parent questionnaire. We received 18 responses in total, which is great!

We are very pleased with the results for questions two to six..


- **Q2)** Every year group was represented and in some year groups we received a repsonse for all children.

- **Q6)** We take bullying seriously and are pleased that parents feel any incidents of bullying are dealt with quickly and effectively.











We have several times during the year when you can find out how well your child is doing, -

- End of Year Reports in the Summer Term


In addition to these our staff are always available if you would like to arrange a time to discuss how well your child is doing.




The children at our school cover the learning set out in the National Curriculum. This covers the following subjects, - English, Mathematics, RE, Science, Art and Design, Computing, Design and Technology, French (Years 5 and 6), Geography, History, Music, PE and PSHE.
