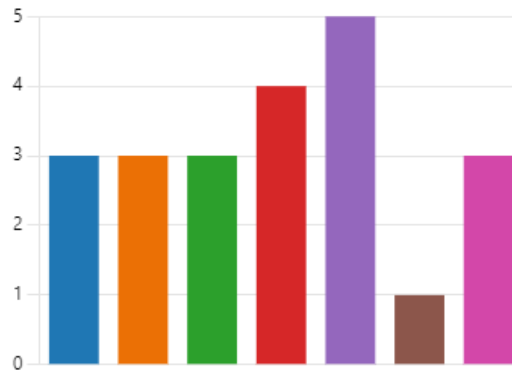
Thank you to everyone who completed the parent questionnaire. We received 18 responses in total, which is great!
