Information Technology	Using computers and other technology to help store, share, and protect information, like making sure your school records stay safe and can be easily found.
Computer	A machine that can help you do many things like play games, learn, write, and find information. It follows instructions to do tasks really quickly.
Barcode	A special code made up of lines and spaces that you see on products at stores. It holds information about the product, like its price, which the computer can read.
Scanner	A device that reads barcodes or other information and sends it to a computer. It works a bit like an eye that "sees" and understands codes.
Scan	The action of using a scanner to read information
