


What I already know

Key Vocabulary	Definition
music	A group of sounds that people have arranged in a pleasing or meaningful way.
feelings	An emotion. Love, anger, joy and fear are human feelings.
pattern	Something that happens or appears in a regular and repeated way.
rhythm	Patterns of long and short sounds used in music.
pulse	The heartbeat or steady beat of a song/ piece of music.
pitch	How high or low a note sounds
tempo	The speed of a song or piece of music.
notes	Small bits of sound.
instrument	An object or device for producing musical sounds.
open	Allowing access. Not closed or blocked.
edit	To change or correct.
save	To keep and store something.
