- I know how to consider whether Jesus' good news is only good news for Christians or whether there are things for people from different worldviews to consider

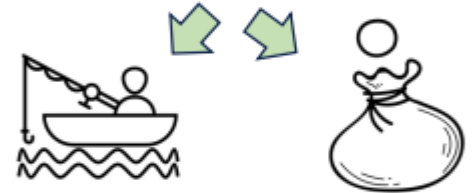
### Key Knowledge- What I will know at the end of the unit

## Key Vocabulary

## Definition

**Christians** – People who love and follow Jesus.

**Jesus** – God's Son who teaches people to love others.

**Matthew** – A man who followed Jesus and wrote part of the Bible.

**Fishermen** – People who catch fish for a living.

**Disciples** – Followers of Jesus who learned from him.

**Tax collector** – A person who collects money for the government.

**Peace** – Feeling calm and happy, not fighting.

**Forgiveness** – Saying sorry and letting go of hurt feelings.

**Apostles** – Special followers of Jesus who helped spread his teachings.

**Prayer** – Talking to God to ask for help or thank Him.
