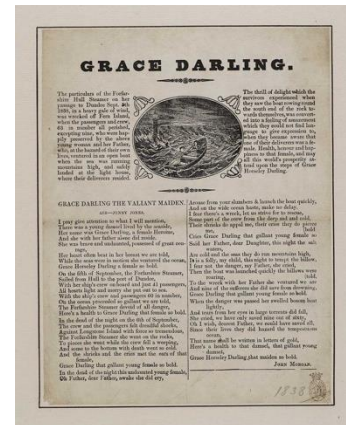

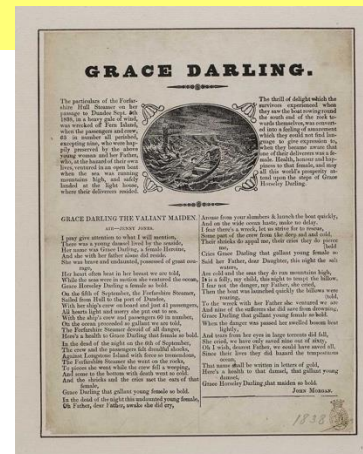

<b>Rescue</b>	Saving someone or something from danger or trouble.
<b>Lighthouse</b>	A tall building by the sea with a bright light on top that helps ships stay safe and not crash at night.
<b>Shipwreck</b>	When a ship gets broken and sinks in the water, usually in an accident.
<b>Heroic</b>	Very brave and doing something amazing to help others, even if it's hard or scary.
<b>Fearless</b>	Not being scared, even when facing something tough or dangerous.
<b>Courageous</b>	Being brave and doing the right thing, even if it's scary.
<b>Evidence</b>	Clues or proof that help show something is true.
<b>Everyday Life</b>	The things people do regularly, like eating, going to school, working, or playing.
<b>Version</b>	A different way of telling a story or making something. For example, two people might tell the same story in slightly different ways.
<b>Differences</b>	How things are not the same as each other.
<b>Views</b>	Opinions or ideas about something. What someone thinks.
<b>Reasons</b>	Why someone does something or why something happens.
<b>Sources</b>	Where you find information, like books, pictures, or the internet.
<b>Newspaper</b>	Paper or online stories that tell people about what's happening in the world.
<b>Victorian</b>	A time in history when Queen Victoria ruled Britain, a long time ago. People had different clothes, homes, and ways of doing things than today.
