



Rescue	Saving someone or something from danger or trouble.
Lighthouse	A tall building by the sea with a bright light on top that helps ships stay safe and not crash at night.
Shipwreck	When a ship gets broken and sinks in the water, usually in an accident.
Heroic	Very brave and doing something amazing to help others, even if it's hard or scary.
Fearless	Not being scared, even when facing something tough or dangerous.
Courageous	Being brave and doing the right thing, even if it's scary.
Evidence	Clues or proof that help show something is true.
Everyday Life	The things people do regularly, like eating, going to school, working, or playing.
Version	A different way of telling a story or making something. For example, two people might tell the same story in slightly different ways.
Differences	How things are not the same as each other.
Views	Opinions or ideas about something. What someone thinks.
Reasons	Why someone does something or why something happens.
Sources	Where you find information, like books, pictures, or the internet.
Newspaper	Paper or online stories that tell people about what's happening in the world.
Victorian	A time in history when Queen Victoria ruled Britain, a long time ago. People had different clothes, homes, and ways of doing things than today.
