money	Coins or paper we use to buy things.
save	Keeping your money so you can use it later
safe place	A special spot where your money stays so it doesn't get lost, like a piggy bank.
working together	Helping each other to get something done
responsibility	Doing what you should, like cleaning up your toys.
helpful	Doing nice things to make things easier for others.
caring	Being kind and showing love to people
bank	A small, round piece of money made of metal
coin	A small, round piece of money made of metal
note	A piece of paper money.
worth	How much something is valued or how much money it costs.
saving	Keeping money so you can use it later
safe	Something that keeps you or your things protected
hazard	Something that can be dangerous
kettle	A pot that heats water
first aid	Helping someone who is hurt before a doctor comes

Word	Definition
risk	Something that might be unsafe or cause a problem
accident	When something happens by mistake, like falling down
danger	Something that can hurt you, like a hot stove or a busy road
safe	Not in danger; nothing can hurt you
burn	When something hot hurts your skin,
scald	A burn from something really hot, like boiling water.
Accident	When something bad happens by mistake,
emergency	A big problem that needs fast help
help	Doing something nice to make things easier for someone
share	Letting someone use or have part of what you have.
Take turns	Waiting for your turn so everyone gets a chance.
listen	Paying attention to what someone is saying.
gamer	Someone who plays games, like on a phone, computer, or video game console
Personal information	Things about you, like your name, address, or phone number.
internet	A place on the computer or phone where you can find information and talk to people.
risk	Something that might be unsafe or cause problems.
