


Sticky learning

paintbrush	A tool you use to put paint on paper or a canvas to make pictures.
pencil	A tool for drawing or writing.
eraser	A tool that helps you remove mistakes or marks.
fill tool	A tool on a computer that colours in big areas quickly.
spray can	A tool that sprays paint like tiny dots.
undo	A button that lets you go back if you made a mistake
Piet Mondrian	An artist who liked to make pictures using straight lines and big blocks of red, yellow, and blue.
shape tool	A tool that helps you make different shapes.
line tool	A tool that draws straight lines for you on the computer.
Wassily Kandinsky	An artist who painted colourful shapes and lines to show different feelings.
tools	Things that help you make or do something.
Georges Seurat	An artist who used lots of tiny dots of colour to make pictures
brush size	How big or small the brush strokes are when you paint.
pictures	Drawings, paintings, or photos that show something.
painting	Making pictures using paint and a brush or other tools
computers	Machines that can help you make art, play games, or find information
like	When you feel happy or enjoy something
prefer	When you like something more than something else.
dislike	When you do not like something.
