

Key Vocabulary

Photography	An image that has been captured by a camera.
Camera	A tool or device that takes pictures or videos.
Landscape	A photo of nature, like mountains, trees, or a sunset.
Portrait	A photo of a person or group of people, usually showing their face.
Framing	How you choose what to include in a photo, like putting a tree or a person in just the right spot.
Subject	The main thing or person you are taking a picture of.
Compose	Deciding where everything goes in a photo to make it look nice.
Light sources	Anything that gives light, like the sun, lamps, or candles, to help you take pictures.
Flash	A quick, bright light from the camera to help take pictures in the dark.
Editing	Changing a photo to make it look better, like making it brighter or adding colours.
Filter	A special effect you can add to a photo to change how it looks, like making it black and white or extra colourful.
