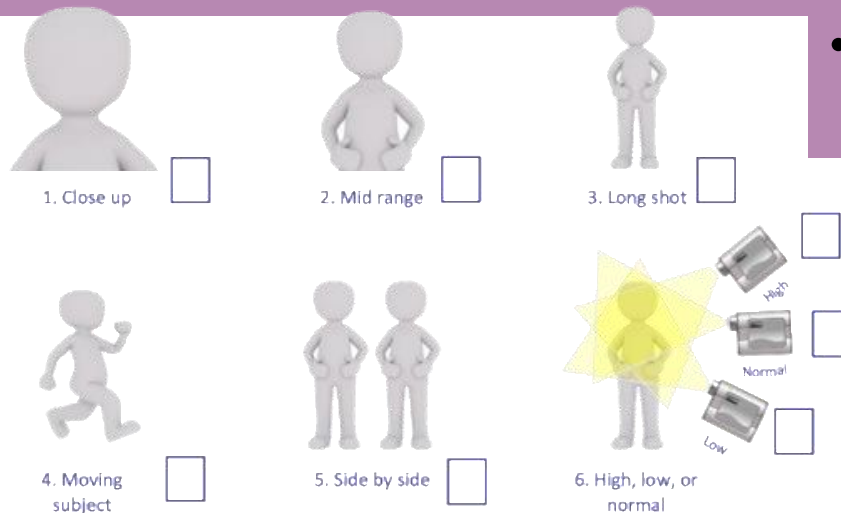
Creating media - Video production

| Video | visual media format |
| Panning | Slowly moving the camera from side to side to show more of a scene. |
| Close-up | A shot that shows something very close, like a person's face or a small object, to show details. |
| Mid-range | A shot that shows a person or object from about the waist up, so you can see both details and background. |
| Long shot | A shot that shows the whole person or object and a lot of the background to set the scene. |
| Subject | The main person or thing that the video or picture is focused on. |
| Zoom | Making something look closer or farther away without moving the camera. |
| Pan | Moving the camera from left to right or right to left to show more of a scene. |
| Tilt | Moving the camera up or down to show something above or below. |
| Storyboard | A set of pictures or drawings that show what will happen in a video, like a comic strip for movies. |
| Split | Cutting a video into two parts to edit it. |
| Trim | Cutting off the beginning or end of a video to make it shorter. |
| Reshoot | Recording a video again to make it better. |
